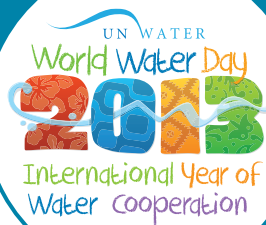

RAISE MONEY

As well as raising awareness about the importance of clean water and sanitation, you can also raise money. The event is free to enter, but if you'd like to make a donation, it will be used to buy water tanks for villages in the Pacific who can't easily access clean water.

THE RIGHT TO CLEAN WATER

One in ten of the world's population does not have access to clean water or safe sanitation. Because of this, more than two million people die from water related diseases every year. Walking long distances to find clean water stops children going to school, affects jobs and livelihoods, and dramatically reduces the life expectancy for elderly, sick and disabled people.

Access to clean water and safe sanitation would help break the poverty cycle, improve education and save lives all over the world. Walk for Water this year and stand up for the right to clean water for everyone.

WORLD WATER DAY

The first World Water Day took place in March 1993. Now International World Water Day takes place every year to highlight the importance of clean water and managing our freshwater resources effectively.

WHEN AND WHERE

Organised by Unitec and Rotary, Walk for Water takes place on **Saturday 23 March at 10am**. You can choose from one of the following start locations:

- » **Ken Maunder Park in New Lynn**
- » **Cox's Bay Reserve in Cox's Bay**
- » **Potters Park on the corner of Dominion and Balmoral Roads**

The Walk finishes up at Unitec's Mt Albert campus where you can kick back and relax with family-friendly games, activities, and of course some well-deserved food from a range of different stalls.
