WASTED YOUTH?

Dale Williams had a problem. He inherited the leadership of a small town that was facing high rates of youth crime and unemployment, vandalism, and the looming threat of closing businesses. He implemented creative solutions, significantly improving local systems

in Otorohanga as Chair of the Mayors Taskforce for Jobs with its goal of “zero waste of youth.”

Over the last nine years:

- Youth crime cut by 75%
- 0% registered youth unemployment
- 96% completion rate of trade apprenticeships (compared to national average of 35%)
